We will be staying at the Bluelake Inn, South Lake Tahoe, CA again this year, within a few blocks of the casinos and across from the Heavenly gondola. Each room has a refrigerator and microwave.

Downhill

We'll be playing it by ear and taking advantage of any lift ticket deals that are offered by the 16 different ski areas (Squaw, Heavenly, Sierra, Northstar, Alpine Meadows, Kirkwood, etc.). We will contact participants if we need money to pre-buy some of the tickets.

Cross country

Seven areas to choose from. Areas like: Royal Gorge; Tahoe Donner; Northstar; Diamond Peak; Spooner Lake, etc.

On this trip, air is not included. We carpool down. However, flying to Reno and renting a car, or grabbing a shuttle to South Lake Tahoe is another easy option. If you do not have a roomie, one will be assigned - if available. We will have a pre-trip meeting in late January or early February for clubs located in the Portland, OR area to discuss travel and to answer any questions you might have.
